Mapped areas where glacial drift crops out at the Lake surface are shown in yellow, adapted from Rukavina (1976), and Fuller and Foster (1998). Moraines from southern Ontario are shown in blue from Chapman and Putnam (1961) and in green from Barnett (1998) for spatial comparison with the lake floor moraines.
