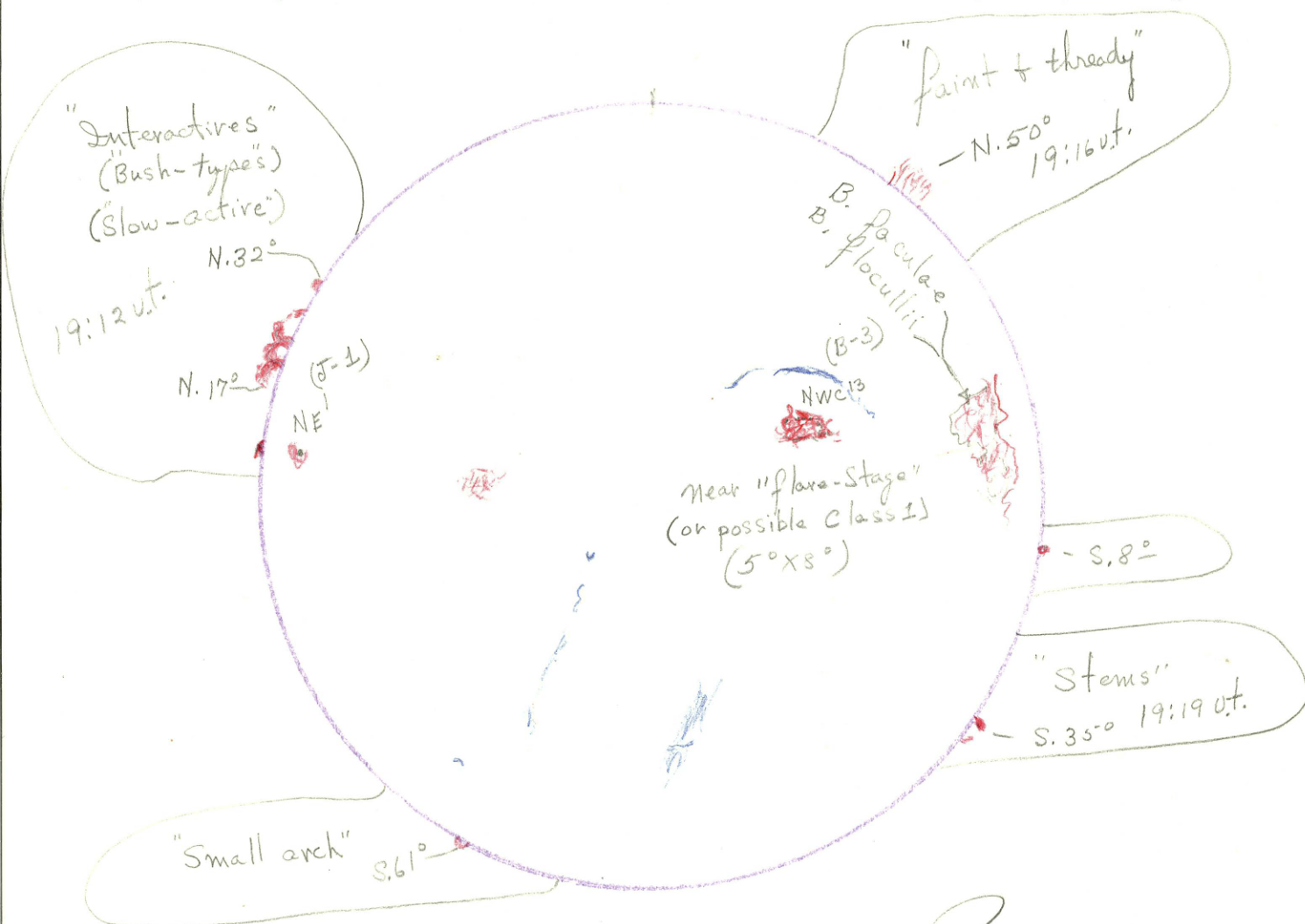

Solar Limb: Very good.

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" — 10" aperture Spectroheliograph - (Ha)

Remarks: The NWC<sup>13</sup>-(B-3)-group of "horse-shoe" configuration. Bright material might be termed a class 1 flare, although very "shreddy" — or "Brightly striated". yesterday's S.6°E.85° — "limb-flare" evidently not in conjunction with today's NE<sup>1</sup>-(J-1) spot, as there is 12° degrees differential — while other limb-material "holds" positive positioning.
