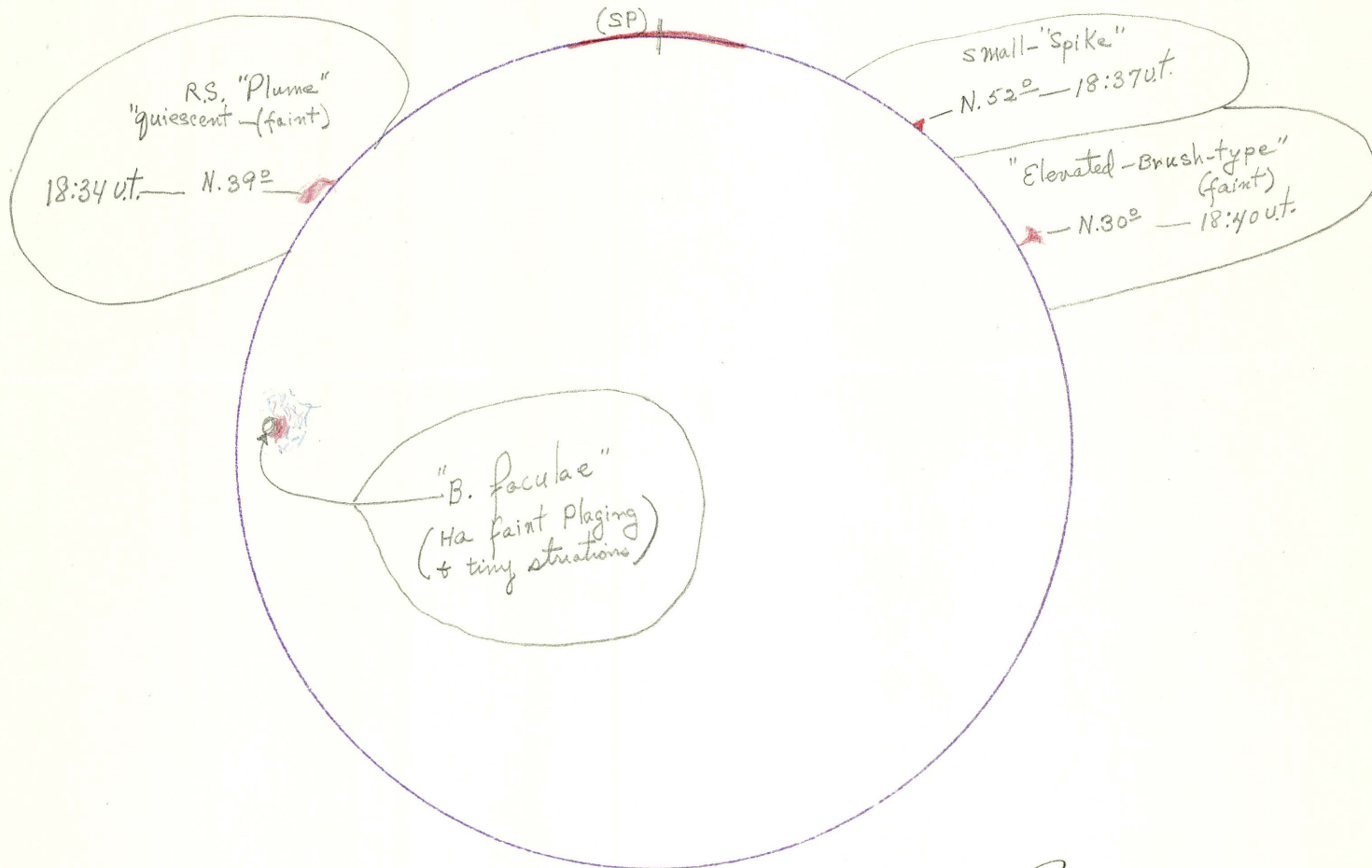


Day Solar Report: NORTHWESTERN OBSERVATORY

Times: 18:17 ut. — 18:24 ut. — 18:26 ut. — 18:35 ut.
 "Plotter" — Spectroheliograph — (Ha)

Sky Condition: clear — "light-blue" — very warm

Solar Limb: very good (scope) — only average (graph)

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" — 10" aperture Spectroheliograph — (Ha)

Remarks: Trials for North Polar Region *only fair, but gave evidence of

tiny, thin radial spicules, (20%) — other features of "fan-type", "ragged-toes" (80%)
 1/2" width — 6" heights | 6" widths — 15" heights

* (warm-air-conditions of day, bothering)
