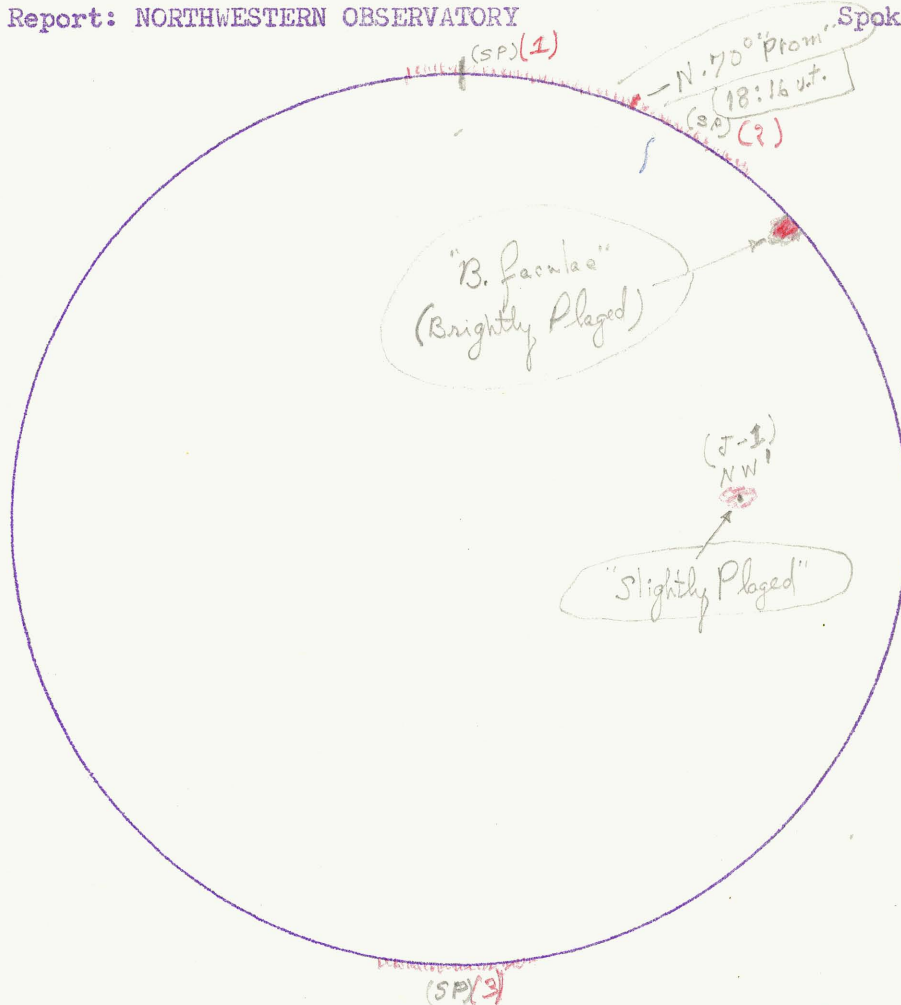

Sky Condition: Clear — "light Blue"

Spectroheliograph — Vector (Ha)

Solar Limb: very good, by "spells".

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" — 10" Spectroheliograph — Vector — (Ha)

Remarks:

(1) north Polar Region spicules show further "collapse" from 11 September, the largest features being widely separated.

(2) area about N. 70° "Prom" having features of great sizes (5" x 15")

(3) South Polar Regions Spicules much the same as for 11 September.
