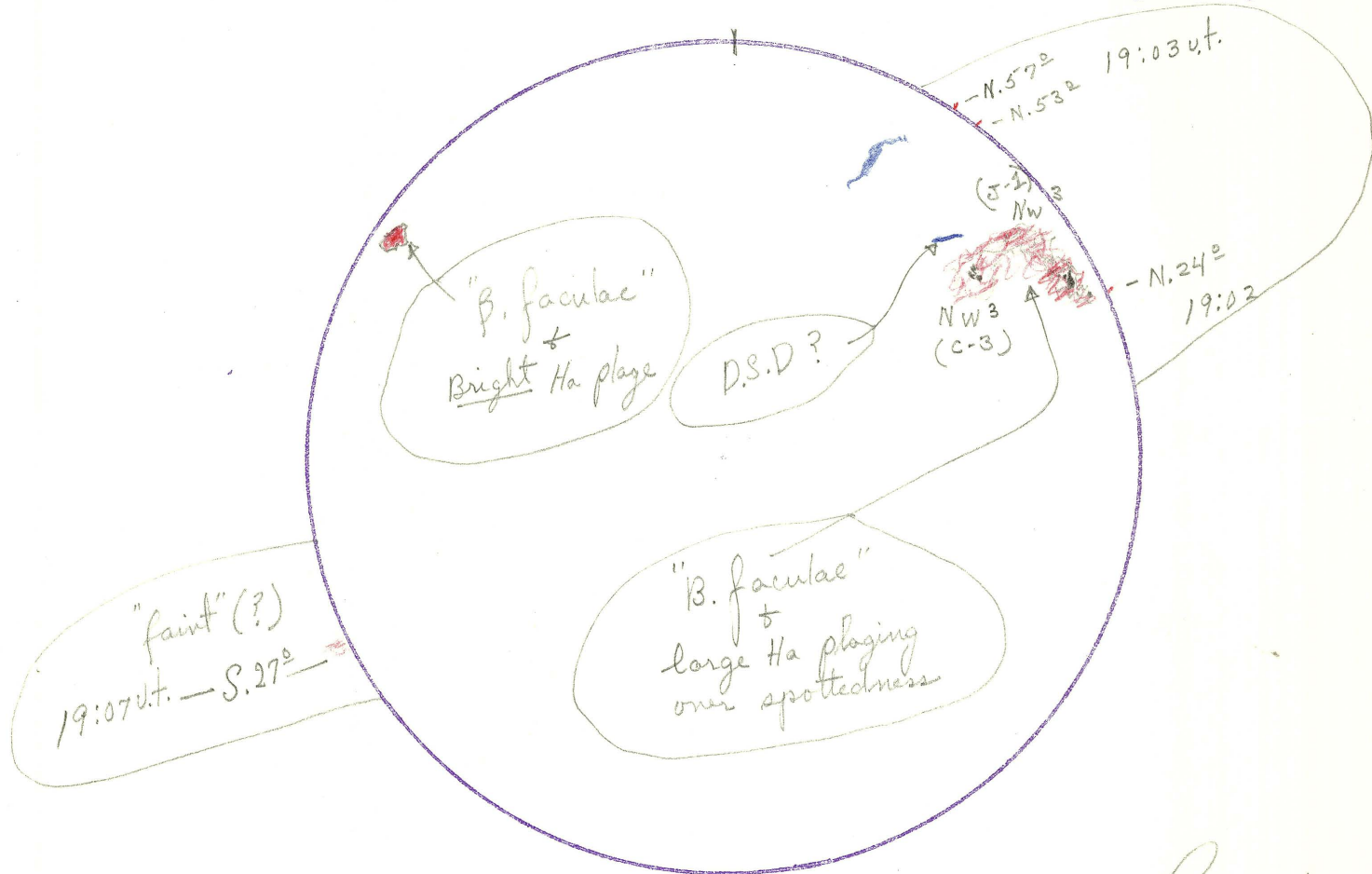

all N.W. Limb-features of "tiny" extent — appearance of "quiescence" — rather than "short-lived" materials.
