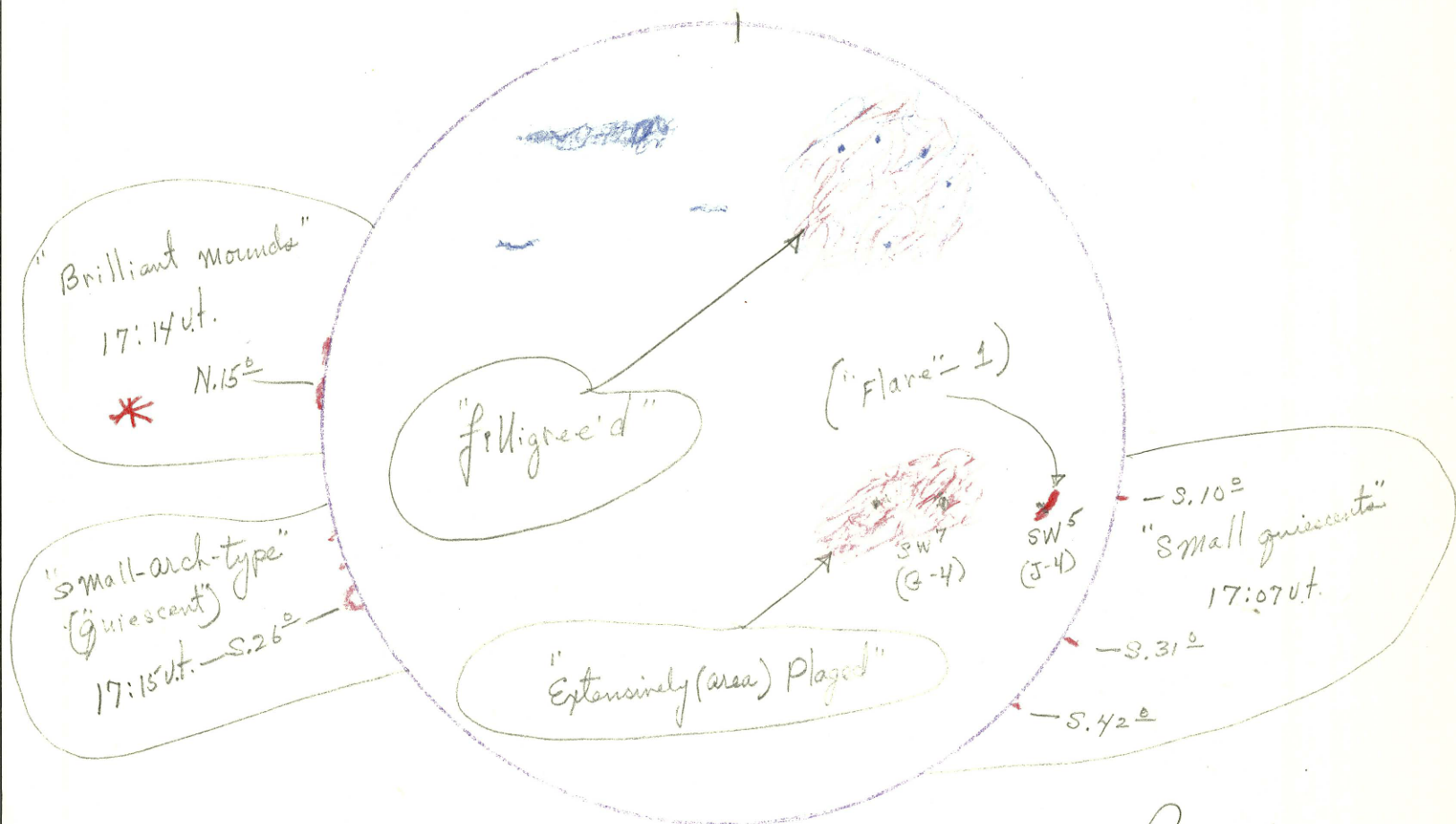

Remarks: * The N. 15°/E. 90° "Brilliant mounds" proved to be two small, but brilliant "limb flares", and one small, but brilliant "surge". Observed in the course of spirules - program observation.

"General" appearance that of activity "building" for this point on E. Limb, and possibly on far solar-limb-contour.
