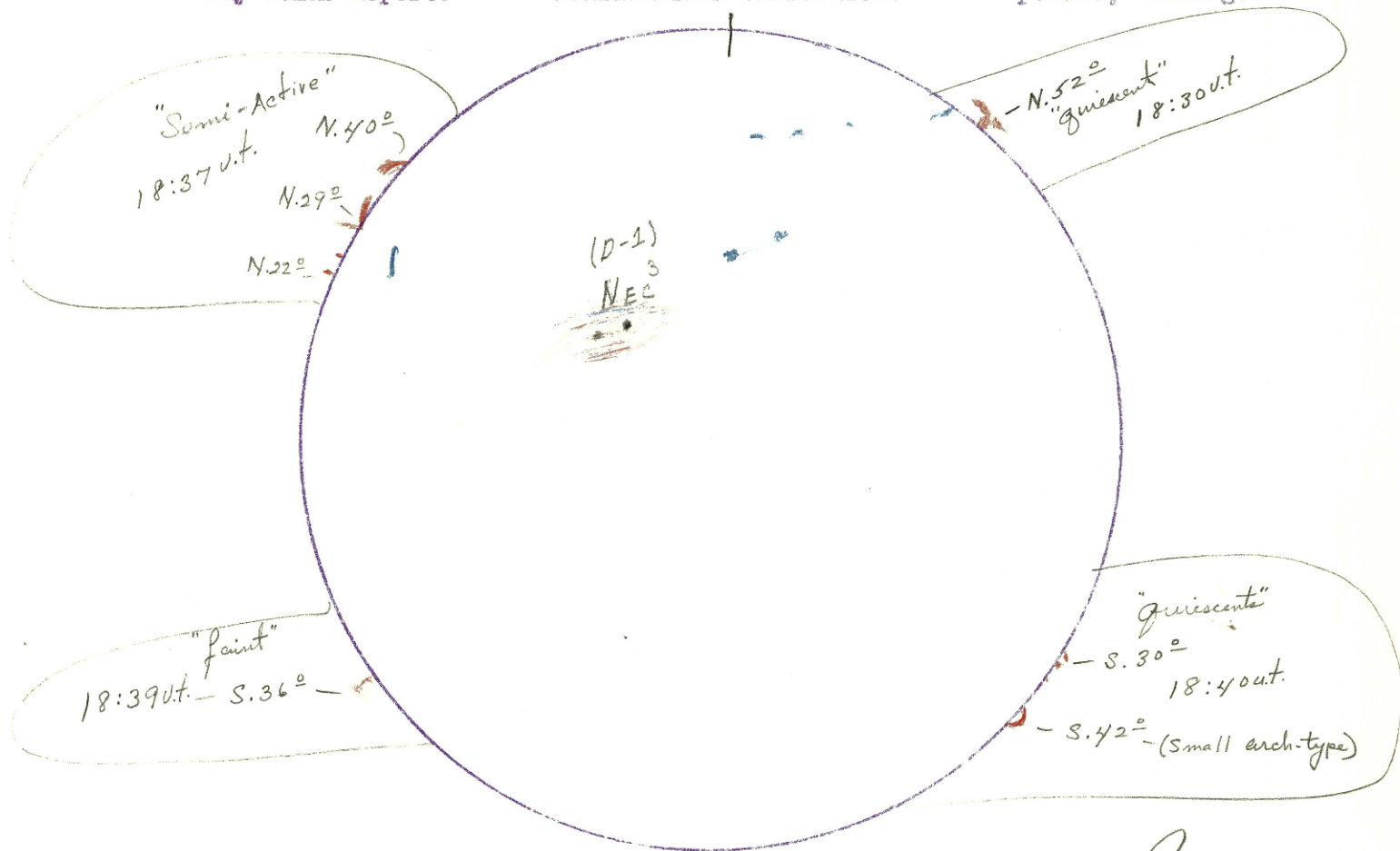


Day Solar Report:

"Plotter"

Spectroheliograph (Ha)

Sky Condition: Clear, (a few clouds about) (wind-gusts) (cold)

Solar Limb: fair, to good, by "spells" — wind bothering

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" — 10" aperture tower Spectroheliograph (Ha)

Remarks closed down finally, because of wind-disturbances —

Orientation may be slightly incorrect due to having been away from the observatory for a period of approx. 10 days, when no daily observations could be made.
