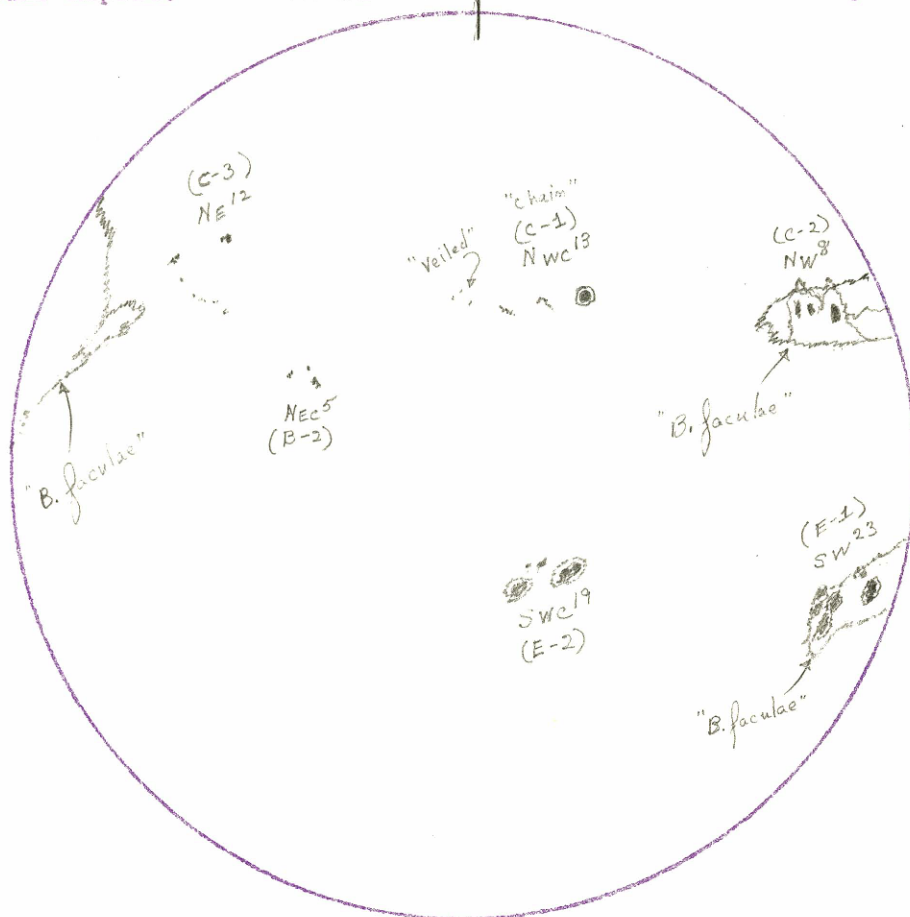

Sky Condition: clear, but lowered Sun in haze "sunward" (cold 23°)

Solar Limb: good, by "spells"

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" only — no H α observations

The four H/s main groups west of cm quite complex, and having pronounced penumbral areas about complexity.
