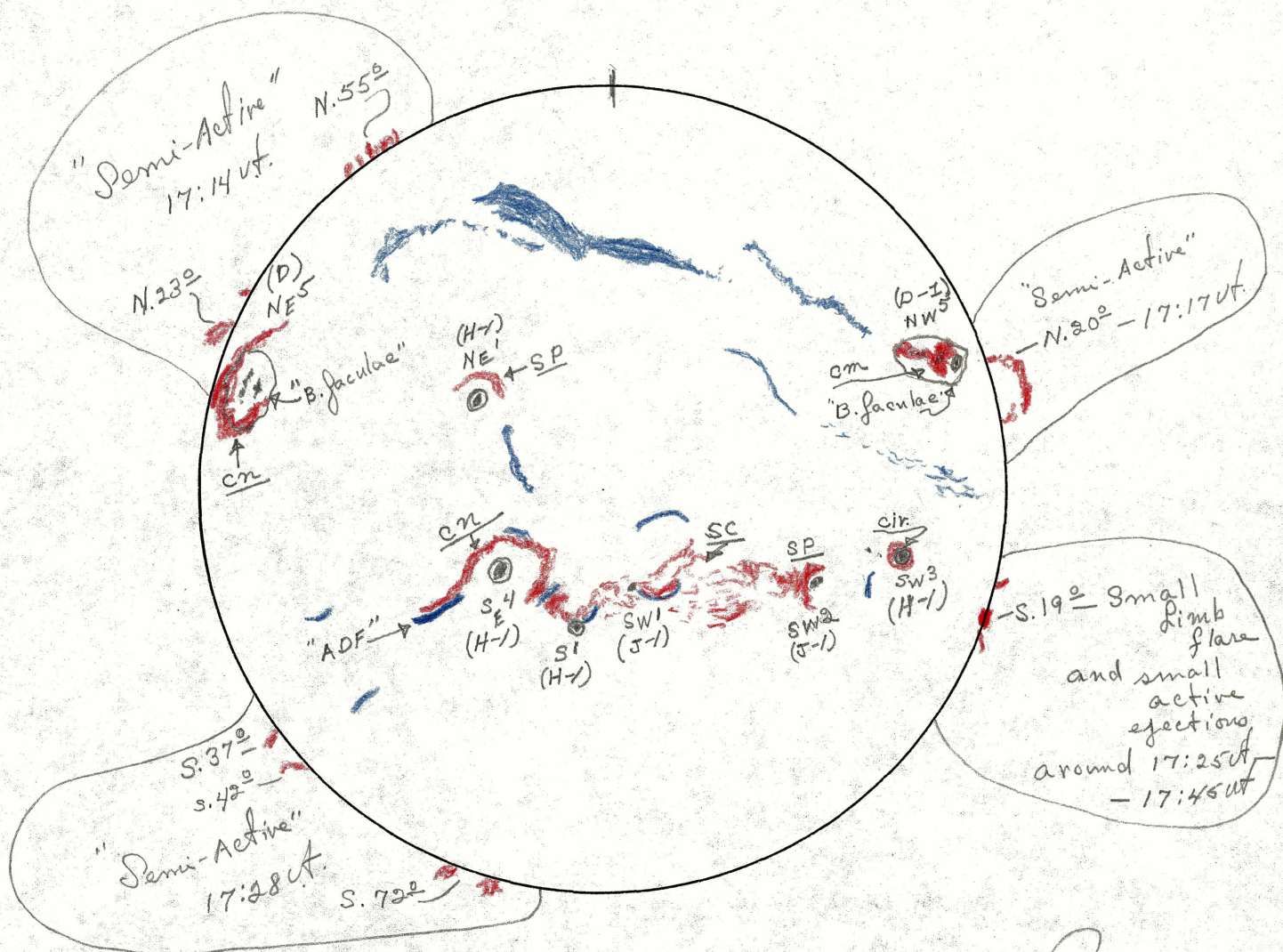




Date: 4 May, 1970

Sky Condition: Partially clear (broken overcast moving in)

Solar Limb: fair, to very excellent, intermittently

Apparatus Used: 7" image "Plotter" - 10" aperture tower / Spectroheliograph > H α

Remarks: S. 19° / N. 90° Small limb flare considered the most active region during shortened observing period before clouds hampered further observations; all H α -shown disk intensities being "moderate".
